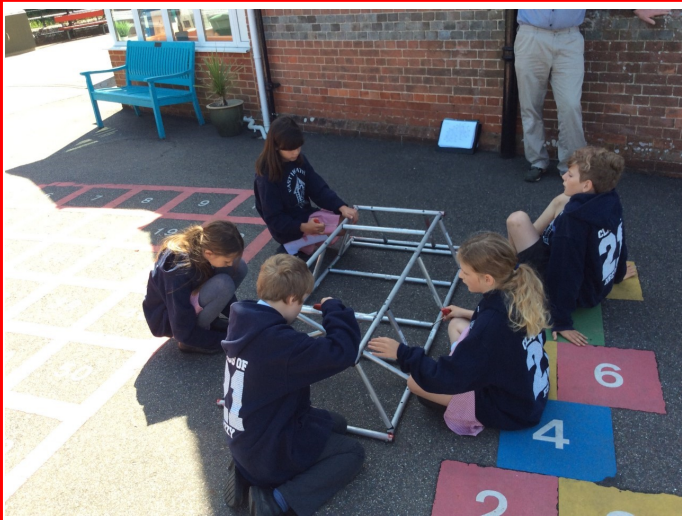
### Why did we build it?!

# Nursery News - Week commencing 07/06/2021

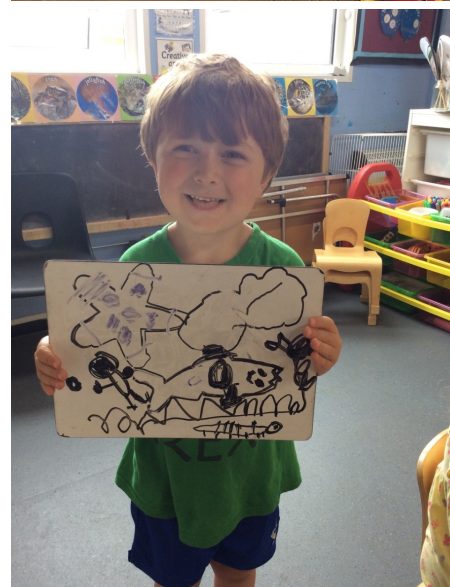
## Messy Play/Independent Learning Indoors
