
A message from the Head of School

- Enjoyed a wide range of community-based events



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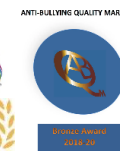
The Pioneer Federation
