Homework				
Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure it is signed and dated.			
Spellings	Spelling tests are every Thursday and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt about the previous week. The new spellings will go out on Friday .			
Maths	Maths homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed by the following Friday . Maths homework will be set on 'MyMaths'. If your child(ren) find the task tricky, there is a revision lesson that they can use first. Parents are encouraged to sit with their child(ren) during homework.			
Times Tables	Children will learn their tables and practise these in school at least twice a week. Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.			
Grammar	Grammar homework will be sent home on a Monday and your child will have 2 weeks to complete this. The homework will be based on the grammar they will be learning within their literacy lessons. This should take around 40 minutes . To help with our in-class assessments, please indicate when you have helped your child.			

<u>Reminders</u> – Please can you make sure: your child brings in a water bottle each day with fresh water; all jumpers are labelled and they have a coat for any wet weather. PE will be on a **Monday** so please ensure your child has their PE kit on this day.
