
<u>'Toys'</u> Squirrel Class Newsletter Term 1 2022

Home Learning

If you would like a learning activity to complete at home during this term with your child, you can choose from one of these activities:

- Ask a family member about the favourite toy they had when they were younger, why
 was it their favourite?
- Play a board game with members of your family, how have the games we play changed?
- Have a go at making your own board game.
- Design a new toy, what would it be like?

Additionally, the children have access to a wealth of activities on Purple Mash. The children have their logins stuck inside their reading records should you need it.

Reading	We are very excited to be sharing our new reading scheme with you and will be sending home information about it. Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated.
Phonics/ spelling	On a Monday, the children will be sent home with spellings based on the spelling curriculum rules and phonics sounds they have been taught during the week. There will be an optional test which the Year 2 children can choose to take part in on a Monday .
Maths	A maths challenge will be set on a Monday and will need to be returned on the following Monday . The children can bring it back in whenever they have finished it during that week and put it in the 'finished homework' box.
