Dear Parents,

Our topic for Term 3 will be, 'Roald Dahl'. Over the term, we are delving into the wonderful world of Roald Dahl – it'll be the perfect opportunity to get lost in literature! With our Golden Ticket in hand, we shall start by exploring the story of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will then look forward to reading Revolting Rhymes, The Twits and lastly, The Giraffe and the Pelly and Me. This term we will be having an Experience Day to immerse ourselves into the world of Roald Dahl. Information regarding this day will be shared with you early in the term.

<b>Reading</b>	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Friday.
<b>Spellings</b>	Spelling tests are every Thursday, and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern and High frequency words they have learnt that week. New spellings will be sent out every Friday.
<b>Maths</b>	Maths homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed by the following Thursday. Maths homework will be set in their CGP Arithmetic books. The children will be given a sheet outlining which pages they should complete in their CGP book for that week.
<b>Times Tables</b>	Each child will have a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.

- Can you share the 7 continents of the world?









