Home Learning:

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. Mrs Robinson will be counting Reading Minutes on a Thursday and these must be signed by an adult to be counted. Year 6 should be reading at least 45 minutes per week and Year 5 for 30 minutes.
Spellings	Spelling tests are every Thursday, and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt about that week. New spellings will be sent out every Thursday.
Maths	Maths homework will be set on a Monday and will be expected to have been completed by the following Monday. Maths homework for Year 5 will be set using weekly 10-minute Arithmetic CPG test books. Year 6 Maths homework will be set in their CGP Arithmetic books. The children will be given a sheet outlining which pages they should complete in their CPG book for that week.
Times Tables	Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.
Grammar	Grammar homework will be sent home on a Monday and your child will have one week to complete this, due in on the following Monday (the same as their Maths homework). The homework will be based on the grammar they will be learning within their literacy lessons. The children will be given a sheet outlining the pages they need to complete from their CPG workbook to help with our in-class assessments, please indicate when you have helped your child.
To help prepare the children for secondary school, in Year 5 and 6, all homework is expected to be completed and handed in on time. The children will complete any missing homework in school time.









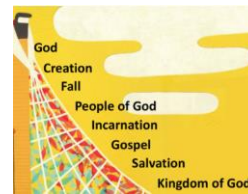
