'Who benefits from Conservation?'

Dear Parents,

We hope you have had a lovely Easter break! This term, our topic is 'Who benefits from Conservation?' and the children will be exploring National Parks locally, and Yellowstone in the USA. We will be developing our written work, as well as editing and refining our grammar skills. There will be a clear focus on grammar gaps on a weekly basis. We will be using our persuasion techniques and speech writing and looking at important issues affecting the planet. We will be developing our reading comprehension skills through short texts, covering the genres of fiction, non-fiction and poetry.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure their record is signed and dated. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Monday. There may be additional reading comprehension tasks to complete this term – these count as reading in the reading records!
Maths	Maths homework will generally be set and collected on a Monday, although there may be additional revision tasks set on an 'as and when' basis. Year sixes are now encouraged to complete any outstanding pages in their CGP books prior to week 4 when they will sit their Maths SATs papers.
Times Tables	Children will learn their tables and practise these in school. Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) at home.
Grammar	Grammar homework will generally be set and collected on a Monday, although there may be additional revision tasks set on an 'as and when' basis. Year sixes are now encouraged to complete any outstanding pages in their CGP books prior to week 4 when they will sit their SPaG SATs papers.

A reminder that it is SATs for Year 6 pupils the week commencing 13th May. We will send out further information shortly.
