Arrangement for Year 6 SATS (Standard Assessment Tests)

We are writing to inform you of the arrangements that are in place during SATs week Monday 13th – Thursday 16th May 2024. These are external assessments and will measure a pupil's progress in punctuation, grammar, spelling, reading and maths. It is essential that your child attends school every day.

Below is the timetable for the tests:

Tuesday 14 th May	Reading Paper	
Wednesday 15 th May	Maths: Arithmetic Paper 1

Thursday 16 th May	Maths: Reasoning Paper 3	

Some children are eligible for adaptations to the way tests are administered. For your information, these adaptations can include,

- A reader (to read the question aloud to the child, except in the Reading paper)
- A scribe (to write the answers as dictated by the child)
- A prompter (to encourage continued focus throughout the test)
- Extra time

SATs are a snapshot of what your child has learnt in primary school and we are proud of the hard work and resilience they have shown in preparing for the tests. They have worked incredibly hard this year and we are really pleased with how they have achieved.

During the week, we would love to invite the Year 6 children into school at **8:20am (Monday to Thursday)** to have breakfast together before the tests begin. There is no charge for this and we would encourage them all to join for a relaxed and reassuring start to the day.
