

Rewards

All the ways children can be rewarded:

Values certificate – this is to celebrate any child demonstrating our school values

Headteacher Award – progress in work

Postcard home from staff

Skills builder stickers and certificates – when children show how they are demonstrating a particular skill

Learning certificates - Lexia and Timetable Rock Stars

House team points – awarded when do something helpful, kind etc.

Each week the winning team earn additional playtime.

PE coach certificate – awarded when showing great team work, PE skills etc

Headteacher Hot Chocolate (seasonal: winter hot chocolate with a digestive/summer squash and strawberries) – when you earn a skills builder sticker you get a raffle ticket. Every Friday two raffle tickets drawn from each class these children will be announced at Celebration assembly to have hot chocolate with the Headteacher. Any children who have received step 1's will not go in the draw that week. Children who receive step 2's or 3's will not go in the draw for the term.



Consequences

If children demonstrate behaviours that are impacting on learning or disruptive to others.

Step 5 - External suspension will also be given after an internal suspension has been given and educational consequences have not had the right impact. A reintegration meeting held with SLT and Parents.

Step 4 - Children will have a internal suspension or external suspension after a step 3. If behaviours persist:

Step 3 - Children will go to SLT and parents will be contacted. A step 3 will also be issued without following any of the other sanctions if a child is physical, dangerous or swears. If behaviours persist:

Step 2 - A step 2 means children in KS1 will lose 15 minutes. KS2 children will lose 30 minutes of lunch time. If behaviours persist:

Step 1 - discussion at playtime to discuss behaviours

2. Helping hand – staff will offer additional support, additional resources, move seats etc.

1. Reinforcing Expectation – clear expectations given to all on how to behave.
