Times Tables	Please can children be using TTRS at home for at least 30 minutes. Times table knowledge will hugely support their maths skills in lesson.
Homework books	Maths and English homework books have a 'workout' per week. These are to handing in on a Monday. We will be starting term 2 on workout 7.

- How would you set up a fair scientific experiment?















