
'Why does change happen?' Year 1 and 2 Newsletter Term 1 2025-2026

Dear Hedgehogs Families,


Welcome back. We really hope everybody had a fun and relaxing summer. We are really looking forward to seeing all the children and starting our new topic. This term we will be exploring,

Home learning:

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week, even if it is just for 5 minutes. When reading with your child, please acknowledge the fact that the book has been read by recording this on Boom Reader. During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading as comprehension and discussion are key reading skills in Year 1 and 2. Hedgehogs are encouraged to change their books regularly, please can you help remind your child when their books need changing.
and	In Year 1 we will initially recap our Level 4 polysyllabic words and adjacent consonants. From Week 3 of Term 1 we will begin Level 5 sounds and Common Exception Words. These will be sent home in the style of a bookmark. Please support your child to read and spell these words at home weekly.
Phonics and Spelling Year 2	We will send home our usual speligns of Common Exception Words and words with specific spellings. This will change weekly. In Year 2 we will be working with Level 6 of Twinkl Phonics. The focus for each week will change and will be reflected in the bookmarks we send home. Please support your child to read and spell these words at home weekly.
Maths	For Maths homework please work through the weekly activities set on Mathletics. These will relate to their current learning or learning to come. These activities with support the consolidation the elements of maths we are covering.
