

Dear Rabbit Families,



Home Learning

I would like to thank you all for your effort with last term's home learning tasks including reading with your children. If you have not already, please log in to Boom Reader and track your child's reading at home as this helps us to determine reading levels. The children have already made great progress with learning sounds and every read will help this to become more secure.

To help with continuity in Phonics throughout Reception and Key Stage 1, we will be sending home a phonics book. This will help to keep all phonics learning in one place and is an opportunity to practice any sounds at home that your child may struggle with. These books will be coming home the week beginning 10^{th} November and will have all level 2 sounds already in. We will then be consolidating level 2 sounds before moving on to level 3. During level 3, each week on a Monday, we will add the bookmark into your child's phonics book of the sounds they will be learning that week. We will also use this in school to highlight any areas to focus on so **please can these be kept in bookbags and be in school daily**.


