RABBITS

Welcome back, Rabbits! This term we will be learning all about the seaside, oceans and ocean animals! We started off by reading 'The Snail and the Whale', a book the children are familiar with already. After reading this story and discussing the different places the snail travelled to on the whale's tail, we wrote our own postcard describing where we would want to travel if we had the opportunity. In groups we researched one of the following: Amazon Rainforest, Sahara Desert and Antarctica. We noted the climate, terrain, animals that live there and how these places are different to our country. In maths, we have been learning to group and share objects equally. Our phonics learning this week has concentrated on consolidating all of our tricky words and reading/writing three letter adjacent consonants. Keep up the fantastic hard work Rabbit Class!

It is the last term already! I cannot believe how quickly this year has gone by. This term we are learning about 'The Stone Age to Iron Age'. The year fours have done this previously, so I have made sure to change the English and History lessons to ensure it is different or more challenging content for them. This week in English we have started to read 'The stolen Spear'. We made our own fictional Stone Age maps, inspired by the ones many have at the beginning of the story, we wrote setting descriptions using prepositions, and we created character profiles and character descriptions. In maths we have been learning about money and have been using our knowledge of decimals to help us grasp the concept. Fox class have enjoyed using the money resources during the lessons and are extremely speedy when asked to show an amount. In science we learnt about teeth and the different functions our teeth have. In DT they did some lovely cave art with Mrs Hollamby. In RE we discussed our life journeys and thought about milestones we have already had in our lives and potential important ones in the future.
