RABBITS

What a scorcher! ☀️ Well done, Rabbits for being so wonderful this week in the heat. We listened to 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' and discussed the negative impact that pollution has on our oceans. We created our own 'save our oceans' posters and wrote a sentence about sea pollution. We learnt about Marine Biologist Dr Sylvia Earle and thought of a question we would ask her if we met her. In maths, we have been working on visualising, building and mapping and I have been very impressed with how confident the children are with this. Have a restful weekend!

HEDGEHOGS



Hedgehogs have been working hard learning about similarities and differences between fairy stories this week, as well as adapting and changing fairy stories with our own ideas.

In Maths we have been learning about mass and had great fun comparing the mass of different objects in the classroom. We then tried some trickier learning comparing mass using cubes and solving problems such as 'if a pear has a mass of 3 cubes and a pineapple has a mass of 9 cubes, how many pears weigh the same as one pineapple?'. We greatly enjoyed our reenactment of the Battle of Hastings with Miss Backler this week. The children worked really hard on their shields and loved their opportunity to use foam swords to feel how it have been during the real battle!

It has been such a hot week but the children have coped really well. This week we have been making our own story books to publish our mystery narrative about a stolen item. In maths we have started learning about shapes, such as the properties of triangles and quadrilaterals. In history we started looking at the Bronze Age and learning about the grave of the Amesbury Archer. The children thought like historians and drew conclusions about who he was based on the remaining artefacts and ornaments in his grave. In Forest school they had lots of fun making finishing touches to dens and then testing them to see if they were waterproof. It was a refreshing cool off for Foxes in the heat! 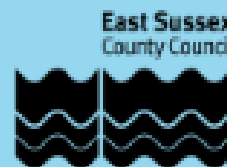

Family Activity and Wellbeing Boxes are a resource that can be borrowed by library members for free

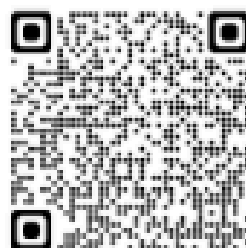
