Workshops & courses

We run regular, free <u>workshops</u> for parent carers in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex on topics such as SEN support in school, EHCPs, disability benefits, the transition to adulthood, and more.

Support and social groups

We offer free support and social groups for parent carers (via our <u>Face 2 Face befriending</u> project) and young people aged 14 to 25 (via our <u>Amazing Futures peer support</u> project). The groups take place online or at various locations in Brighton & Hove and East Sussex.

Help with claiming disability benefits

If you want to <u>make a claim for DLA or PIP</u> for a child or young person, Amaze can offer you free advice and sometimes practical support, if you have extra challenges.

Leisure discount card

Our free <u>Compass Card</u> gives leisure discounts for 0 to 25 year olds with SEND in Brighton & Hove or West Sussex. East Sussex families can get an <u>i-go card</u>.

Getting your voice heard

Amaze supports local parent carer forums (<u>PACC</u> and <u>ESPCF</u>) to make sure the voice and views of parent carers are central to planning SEND services.
