**Re: KS2 SATs Week**

In preparation for the end of key stage 2 assessments, we would like to inform you of the arrangements for the week.

The Year 6 KS2 SATS will be administered during the week commencing **Monday 9 May 2022**.

These are external assessments and will measure pupils' progress in Reading, Punctuation, Grammar, Spelling and Maths and therefore it is essential that your child attends school every day.

To ensure that your child is ready and relaxed for the tests, Year 6's will be able to come into school from 8.20am during SATS week.

Mrs Riley will be holding a short, informal meeting on **Tuesday 26 April at 3.30pm** in Oaks classroom to give you information about the test procedures and answer any questions you may have. The aim is to help you best support your child in the lead up to SATS and during SATS week.

If you would like to attend the meeting but are unable to, then please see Mrs Riley directly and she will arrange to see you another time.

The SATs timetable runs as follows:

- Monday - English GPS Paper 1: questions English grammar, punctuation and spelling Paper 2: spelling
- Tuesday - English reading
- Wednesday - Mathematics Paper 1: arithmetic Mathematics Paper 2: reasoning
- Thursday - Mathematics Paper 3: reasoning

The SATS are a snapshot of what your child has learnt in primary school and we are proud of the hard work and resilience they have shown in preparing for the tests.
