Dear Parents,

Firstly, we would like to say how impressed we have been with the children since they have started with us. They are all settling into school life amazingly!

Our topic for this first term is 'Amazing Me'. We will be reading a range of texts such as Farmer Duck, Little Red Hen, Rosie's Walk, Incredible You and Different is a Great Thing to Be. We will be exploring who we are as people and our place in the world. We will think about our family, who we live with and where we live. We will also be learning about our immediate environment, embarking on a tour of our new school and the grounds. Alongside this, we will be working on counting, number recognition and recognising amounts. We will also be developing our foundation understanding of letters and sounds. This year we are starting a new phonics programme 'Little Wandle'. Please refer to the separate letter which provides more information about how it operates.

Reading	Your child will bring a book home each week. It is essential that this is returned each day as we will be using these books in reading sessions. Please do share this book with your child
	as often as you can. Initially, the books that you will share will not have any words in them. At this stage it is really helpful to encourage the children to use the pictures to tell stories. You may like to add a positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please acknowledge that the book has been read by signing and dating in the comments section. We will be holding a reading meeting to discuss reading strategies and to share more information with you in the coming weeks.




