## Dear Parents,

Firstly, we would like to say how impressed we have been with the children since they have started with us. They are all settling into school life amazingly!

Our topic for this first term is 'Amazing Me'. We will be reading a range of texts such as Farmer Duck, Little Red Hen, Rosie's Walk, Incredible You and Different is a Great Thing to Be. We will be exploring who we are as people and our place in the world. We will think about our family, who we live with and where we live. We will also be learning about our immediate environment, embarking on a tour of our new school and the grounds. Alongside this, we will be working on counting, number recognition and recognising amounts. We will also be developing our foundation understanding of letters and sounds. This year we are starting a new phonics programme 'Little Wandle'. Please refer to the separate letter which provides more information about how it operates.

| Reading | Your child will bring a book home each week. It is essential that this is returned each day as <br> we will be using these books in reading sessions. Please do share this book with your child <br> as often as you can. Initially, the books that you will share will not have any words in them. <br> At this stage it is really helpful to encourage the children to use the pictures to tell stories. <br> You may like to add a positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please <br> acknowledge that the book has been read by signing and dating in the comments section. <br> We will be holding a reading meeting to discuss reading strategies and to share more <br> information with you in the coming weeks. |
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| Little <br> Wandle <br>  <br> Sounds | The children will bring home the sounds they have been working on in the week. The <br> children can practice these sounds by writing them, finding words that start with them and <br> cutting pictures out of catalogues. <br> It would be really useful to support the children in identifying these sounds when reading <br> with them. If you need support in knowing the letter sounds please use the video clip <br> recommended below. |
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| Maths | We will be using CBeebies Number Blocks to help with our teaching of numbers. We will be <br> starting with ' 1 ' and then taking a different number every week to understand the value <br> and embed foundations. Other maths activities will be taking place at the same time. This is <br> part of the recommendations from the Maths Mastery approach. |

## Quick Reminders

- Please can you make sure your child brings in a named water bottle and their book bag each day.
- Can the children please always bring a coat particularly as the British weather is unpredictable.
- Our regular PE days are Monday and Friday and PE kits should be worn to school on that day. This will start on Monday 19th September.
