Dear Parents,

Our topic for Term 3 will be, **'Roald Dahl'**. Over the term, we are delving into the wonderful world of Roald Dahl – it will be the perfect opportunity to get lost in literature! With our Golden Ticket in hand, we shall start by exploring the story of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory. We will then look forward to reading Revolting Rhymes, The Twits and lastly, The Giraffe and the Pelly and Me. This term we will be having an **Experience Day** to immerse ourselves into the world of Roald Dahl. Information regarding this day will be shared with you early in the term.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Friday. They will have the opportunity to get to the top of the reading tree if they have read three times and achieve extra reward time on Fridays.
Spellings	Spelling tests are every Tuesday when your child will be tested on the spelling pattern and High frequency words they have learnt that week. New spellings will be sent out every Tuesday and stuck in the reading diary.
Maths	Maths homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed by the following Friday. This term it will be a specific table/tables to revise.
Times Tables	Each child will have a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home. 'Sound check' is great for mixed tables up to 12x12 under speed conditions. If there is a specific table you think your child needs to practise, then that can be set in the 'Jamming' programme.

Questions you could ask your child about their learning this term:
























- What is your favourite story by Roald Dahl?
