Throughout our journey we will be discovering the animals that live there, the four layers that make up the rainforest and finding out about a variety of plants; even ones that can grow without soil! We will be using the texts, The Great Kapok Tree and The vanishing Forest, to support our learning.

Maths	Maths homework will be set on a Friday and will be expected to have been completed by the	
	following Thursday.	
Times Tables	Each child will have a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on	
	this website or in another way) three times a week at home. Please use the 'Soundcheck' game	
	regularly for speed and then 'Jamming' to practise specific tables.
