



Oaks Class – Term 6 Newsletter ‘Inside Out’



Dear Oaks Class Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had a good break and are ready for our final term together! Our topic for Term 6 is 'Inside Out' and we will be using the text 'There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom' by Louis Sachar to support our learning.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is signed and dated. Mrs Riley will be checking on a Monday these must be signed by an adult to be counted. Year 6 should be reading at least 45 minutes per week and Year 5 for 30 minutes. Lexia minutes count towards this but must be recorded in their reading diaries.
Spellings	Spelling tests are on Tuesday and your child will be tested on the spelling pattern they have learnt about that week. Children should be practising their spellings at least twice a week and we have included a 'Spelling Menu' in their homework books with ideas on different ways to do this.
Maths	Maths homework will be set weekly on a Tuesday. The page numbers will be sent home. Please return the book on Monday morning.
Times Tables	Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.
Grammar	Grammar homework will be set weekly on a Tuesday. The page numbers will be sent home. Please return the book on Monday morning.
To help prepare the children for secondary school, in Year 5 and 6, all homework is expected to be completed and handed in on time. The children will complete any missing homework in school time.	

Reminders – Please can you make sure your child brings in a water bottle each day with fresh water, ensure all jumpers are labelled and bring a coat. PE on Monday and Friday for all children. Please ensure your child has their PE kit, in line with school policy and wears it on PE days.
Nail Varnish- There are some children wearing nail varnish and this is not in line with School Policy. Please remove it before coming to school, as it is not fair on other children who follow the guidance.
