

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week , even if it is just for 5 minutes. When reading with your child, please acknowledge the fact that the book has been read by signing and dating in the reading record book .				
	During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading as comprehension and discussion are key reading skills in Year 1 and 2. Children can change their books as frequently as they need to on the way down to Chestnuts class in the morning. Please remind them at drop off if their books need changing.				
Phonics	Most children in Chestnuts will be sent home with a phonics homework sheet on a Monday which will share the sounds, sentences and spelling we will be covering during the week The children can share their learning with you. There will not be a formal spelling test for Chestnuts, however there will always be 5 words at the bottom of the sheet that they have learnt in school that week and it would be great to practise these at home too! Their phonics and spellings all fit in with the reading scheme.
