



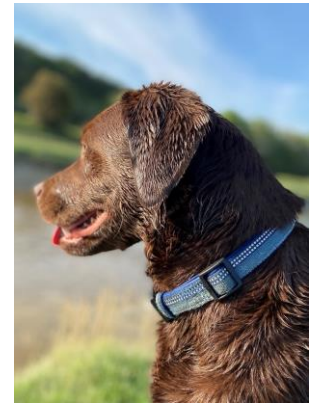

When they are in school, they may visit the children for short periods.



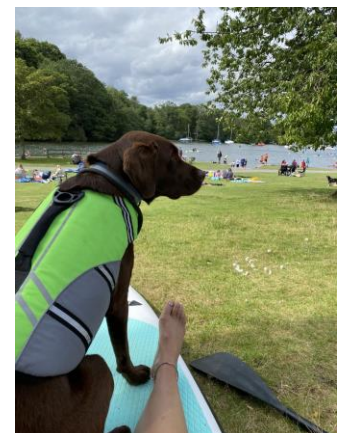
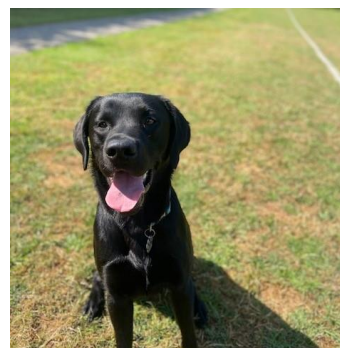
