How did Britain change during this time?

Dear Maple Class families,

Welcome back to Term 6 – the final term of this year! We are looking forward to a busy last term and going back in time to learn about how Britain changed from the Stone Age to the Iron Age, and the impact these time periods had on us today. We will be reading 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura and 'The Stolen Spear' by Saviour Pirotta in our English lessons. We are looking forward to our 'Hands on History' workshop later this term. Homework

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that their reading record is <b>signed and dated</b> by an adult. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Friday. The children are doing incredibly well on Lexia so thank you for all your support with this at home.
Maths	Maths homework continues to be set every Tuesday and the activities are found in the children's homework books. This term, tasks linked to telling the time will be set on Purple Mash.
Times Tables	Each child will have a Times Table Rock stars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week.
Grammar	Homework will continue to be set fortnightly on a Tuesday. The tasks can be found in the children's homework books. Continuing with this learning at home really helps the children retain the vocabulary and terminology we are learning in school. New spellings are set every Tuesday and the children are tested on the following Monday.

**Questions you could ask your child about their learning this term:**

- What happened during the Stone Age?
- What happened during the Iron Age?
- What are hunter gatherers?
- How was Britain different back in the Stone or Iron Age?


