Grammar	Grammar homework will set fortnightly on a Tuesday ready to be handed to
	the teacher the following Monday. This can be handed in early if completed. It
	will be a mixture of spellings, punctuation and grammar.

- How can you overcome challenges?
- How do your dreams and goals differ to those in other religions/countries?
