



Oaks Class Term 3 Newsletter Ancient Egypt

Dear Oaks' Parents and Carers,

We hope you have had a brilliant Christmas holiday and a very happy new year to you all! This term, our topic is **'Ancient Egypt - Can we prove that ancient civilisations were real?'** The children will be learning about what life was like in Ancient Egypt and how it has changed over the years. We will be reading 'Secrets of the Sun King' by Emma Carroll as our guided reading text and becoming YouTube travel guides in our writing. We will also be learning about the Egyptian gods and goddesses and finishing the term by writing our own short, spooky story about a mummy coming to life!. We hope to be off on a trip to a museum in Brighton to learn more about mummification and will write to you with more information soon.

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that a record of this is logged on Boomreader. Year 6 should be reading at least 45 minutes per week and Year 5 for 30 minutes.					
Spellings	Spelling lists will no longer be sent home. We will do 2 spelling lessons a week in class and this may be followed up by a spelling pattern homework page, which will be set as part of the Grammar homework in their CGP books. Below are the spelling patterns/grammar that we will be learning this term:

Maths and Grammar	Maths and Grammar homework will be set weekly on a Tuesday. The pages for this term will be handed out with the books.					
Times Tables	Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising their tables (either on this website or in another way) three times a week at home.					
To help prepare the children for secondary school, in Year 5 and 6, all homework is expected to be completed and handed in on time. The children will complete any missing homework in school time.
