


# <u>'Our Environment;</u> <u>What is special about</u> <u>where we live?'</u>

Dear Families,

Term 2 is an exciting term; we have lots of wonderful learning connected to our terms big question; 'What is special about where I live?' We hope the children will enjoy learning about seasons, plants, their local environment and how it has changed; they will be creating collage with different materials in art, plus much more!

#### Helping to enrich our topics

It is always great to have items that support our topic, so if anyone has any items that may help us with any of the work above that we could borrow, we would love to see them. We will have a topic-based 'show and tell' weekly on a Friday. Please ensure show and tell is TOPIC BASED.

#### Help needed for our topic:

In Science, we will be learning about bulbs and observing over the year when these flower. We will also be learning about seasonal produce in the local area. If anyone has any seeds or bulbs they could donate or knows of any local gardeners/farmers who could enhance our topic by coming in and talking to the children about seasonal produce, please let us know.

#### Useful information and reminders:

- Please can you make sure your child brings in a water bottle and their book bag each day. We use
  their books daily so these need to be placed in a box as they come into the classroom.
- The children will need a **named coat**, **hat and gloves** in school as the weather starts to get colder and wetter.
- Our PE days are Mondays and Fridays so please send your child into school in their PE on these days.

Can we also remind you that we don't allow children to bring toys into school to play with. Last term we have had a few children upset when they have been lost. If a child is struggling with transition then they can bring in a SMALL cuddly toy (no bigger than 15cm) to stay in their bag and cuddle if needed.

#### **Home Learning**

Reading	Please read with your child <u>at least</u> three times a week, even if it is just for 5 minutes. When reading with your child, please acknowledge the fact that the book has been read by recording this on Boom Reader. If you need a reminder of your Boom Reader Log in
	then ask Mrs Adams.
	During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading as comprehension and discussion are key reading skills in Year 1 and 2. Chestnuts are encouraged to change their books regularly, please can you help remind your child when their books need changing.
	Children also have a reading book linked to the reading and phonics scheme sent home weekly on a Friday. Please ensure the folders with these books are back in on Wednesday for us to organise the next round of books for the weekend. Please read this book at least two times to build up stamina and prosody (expression). There are questions at the back you can ask the children to support comprehension too. Purple plus readers who no longer are on the phonics scheme for reading will get comprehension homework weekly.
Phonics Year 1	Attached to the newsletter you will find our Weekly Phonics overview- please read through these words with your child at home to supplement the Phonics teaching we will be completing in class.  Children have been sent a list of key words to practise. These words will help them build their stamina for reading, if they can recall them instantly.
	We will not be setting weekly Spellings.
Spelling Year 2	Please practice the spelling the words from the attached 'common exception words' document.
Maths	Continue instant recall of number facts from the attached sheet. Once they have mastered these then extend by applying this knowledge. i.e. 3+4=7 so 7-3=4, 30+40=70

We hope you all have lovely term supporting the children in their learning. Please do not hesitate to come and speak to us if you have any questions.
