This term we will be studying The Tudors. To introduce the children to the fantastic new topic, we are going on a trip to Hever Castle in December. In literacy, we will be reading 'The Boy and the Globe' by Tony Bradman. This story features the main character meeting William Shakespeare and helping him with the plot for one of his most famous plays! In history, we will be learning all about the monarchy: King Henry VIII and his 6 wives.

#### Homework

Reading	Please read with your child at least three times a week at home and ensure that it is uploaded on Boom Reader. A member of staff will be checking this each Friday to create our reading score.
Lexia	Children are welcome to use their Lexia logins at home at practice their reading, spelling and comprehension skills.
Times Tables	Children will learn their tables and they practise these in school. Each child has a Times Table Rockstars login and should be practising at home. For year 4 this is especially important because later in the year they will have the times table assessment.
Grammar and maths	The children will be set either a piece of grammar or maths homework on a Monday. It needs to be completed and handed in by the following Monday.
