- The curriculum is a strength of the school. All core subjects are integrated into the crosscurricular work. Staff help pupils focus on skills for learning as well as knowledge and understanding and pupils appreciate the opportunities they have to challenge themselves in their learning. There is a culture of trying to do your best, with pupils understanding what they are learning and why.
- School leaders pride themselves on recognising and developing leadership talent in the school. Empowering staff and encouraging them to take on responsibilities. In training them, they have benefited from working alongside colleagues in a federation.
