incualing.	Your child will bring a book home each week from the Little Wandle Scheme. It is		
	essential that this is returned each day as we will be using these books in guided		
	reading sessions three times a week. Please do share this book with your child as often as you can. In addition to this, they can choose other reading books that we		
	have at school. Please ensure that these are returned regularly. Initially, the books		
	that you will share will not have any words in them. At this stage, it is really helpful		
	to encourage the children to use the pictures to tell stories. You may like to add a positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please acknowledge that the		
	book has been read by signing and dating in the comments section. We will be		
	holding a reading meeting to discuss reading strategies and to share more		
	information with you in the coming weeks.		
	The homework letter each week will let you know which sounds they will be working		
	on in the week. The children can practice these sounds by writing them, finding		
	words that start with them and cutting pictures out of catalogues with the correct initial letters. It would be really useful to support the children in identifying these		
	sounds when reading with them. If you need support in knowing the letter sounds		
	please use the video clip recommended below.		
Maths	We will be using CBeebies Number Blocks to help with our teaching of number. We will be starting with '1' and then taking a different number every week to understand		
	the value and embed foundations. Other maths activities will be taking place at the
