
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

Reading/	Please read with your child <b>at least three times a week</b> , even if it is just for 5 minutes. When reading with your child, please ensure it is signed and dated, with the number of minutes that the child has read for included. A member of staff will be checking reading diaries on a Thursday and counting the minutes for miles!  We have introduced our new reading scheme for Year 1 (and some children in Year 2) using Little Wandle books – please read the letter sent home last term carefully, extra copies are available on the school website or from the school office.  During reading sessions, please discuss the story with your child and ask them questions about what they are reading. These questions will help to develop their understanding of what they are reading as comprehension and discussion are key reading skills in Year 1 and 2.
	Children who are not reading Little Wandle books (Purple Band and above) can change their reading books, within their book band, at any time from our class library.
Spellings and phonics	Spellings or Phonics tasks will be given out each week and will be reviewed on <b>Fridays</b> .  Please practise these words with your child at home.
	Please can children continue to learn their times tables at home. Year 1 children should be learning 10x, 2x and 5x tables.
Maths	When secure with the 2x, 5x and 10x tables, Year 2 children should be moving onto 3x and 4x tables.
