# <u>Let's Celebrate!</u> Maple Class Newsletter Term 2 2022




Dear Parents,



#### **Learning Journeys**

We are keen for you to have an opportunity to come in and see your child's learning journeys. We would like to invite you into Maple Class on Monday 7<sup>th</sup> or Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> of November at 3:00pm. Please come to the main entrance of the school so that you can sign in.

#### **Home Learning**

We would like to thank you all for your effort with last term's home learning tasks including reading with your children. The children have already made great progress with learning sounds and every read will help this to become more secure.

Reading	Your child will bring one Little Wandle home each week. They will also be able to choose another book each day. It is essential that they bring both books in each day so that we can use them in group and individual reading sessions. When sharing a book with your child, you may like to add a positive or helpful comment in the reading diary but please acknowledge that the book has been read by signing and dating in the comments section.
Little Wandle Letters & Sounds	The Little Wandle planning is sent to you with the homework, inside their homework books. It is really helpful if you review the sound of the day with your child. It would also be really useful if you could support your child in identifying these sounds when reading with them. If you need support in knowing the letter sounds please use the video clip recommended below. The children are beginning to use their phonic knowledge to write simple words so please do encourage them. At this stage, we encourage the children to sound out words as independently as possible.
Maths	We will be using CBeebies Number Blocks to help with our teaching of number. We will be starting with '6' and then taking a different number every week to understand the value and embed foundations. Other maths activities will be taking place at the same time. This is part of the recommendations from the Maths Mastery approach.

#### Key questions to ask your child at home:

- What do we celebrate?
- Why does the world get dark?
- Who do we remember?
