Our behavior expectations

What's the same?

All sweatshirts or cardigans must have the school logo on them.

Winter: School sweatshirt/cardigan/jumper with the school logo, white shirt with a school tie (elasticated ties are available), grey trousers, shorts or grey skirt/grey pinafore dress (must be knee length), grey, black or white socks or grey, black, white or red tights and black school shoes. Please note – ties must be worn with white shirts, not polo shirts. If wearing a shirt, a tie must be worn with it.

Summer: School sweatshirt/cardigan with the school logo, white polo shirt with school logo or plain white polo shirt, grey trousers, skirt, pinafore dress, shorts or red and white striped (or checked) dress, white, grey or black socks, and black school shoes that cover the child's toes.

Only watches and stud earrings are permitted and hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back. Earrings are required to be covered or removed for P.E. sessions.

PE/Sport Kit:

- Sky blue school T-shirt
- Navy blue school sweatshirt
- Navy blue or black shorts or navy or black leggings
- Black plimsoles (KS2 can have trainers for outdoor use)

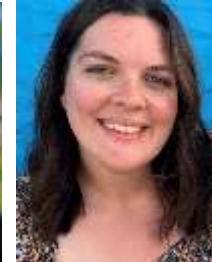
