## What are the benefits for families?

### 1. Improved and targeted services

The information from i-go helps our teams **build a clearer picture** about the need for certain services.

### 2. Exclusive access to over 100 offers and discounts

We have offers ranging from **free** taster sessions, discounts and **free** entry for carers. These include but are not limited to:

- Days out
- Dining out
- Sports
- Arts
- Museums
- Entertainment

We also provide information about **accessibility** for each of our i-go venues to help you **plan a visit**. This includes details about features like toileting, wheelchair access, and sensory information.

### 3. Have your voice heard

i-go families will be some of the first to know about **new opportunities** to get involved, such as taking part in consultations and giving feedback.



## Who is i-go for?

i-go is for **0-25s with additional needs** living in East Sussex, or studying here.

Children and young people who are eligible, might have any of the following:

- An Education Health and Care Plan (EHCP), Blue Badge or concessionary bus pass
- Additional Needs Plan, also known as Specific Support Plan or Provision Map
- A medical diagnosis
- No medical diagnosis, including Social, Emotional, Mental Health Conditions
- Be in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or Personal Independence Payments (PIP)

Please note, if you are applying without a medical diagnosis, a professional who knows your child or young person will need to fill out an application support form.
