Key Concept/ Theme: Place Knowledge	
Next Steps in Learning: How does the geography of Egypt influence its people? Why is Europe so good for holidays? When and where would you go?

1.	<i>How can we describe the geography of Greece?</i> Prior learning reconnection (year group, cycle & term): Continents, specifically Europe Activity: Explore geography of Greece using atlas, Google Earth Label key human and physical features of Greece- islands, main cities, mountains, bordering countries, seas Future learning links: What might this mean for the people living there?
2 May take two sessions	<i>What are the main Greek Islands? What makes them unique?</i> Reconnect- How many features of Greece can we name? Create a fact file poster about the Greek islands in groups- each group has to research and create a poster about their island. Present their findings to the rest of the class. Find out- key town/city, main food, monuments or buildings, history, population, weather, special features, why do people visit? After the presentations, vote which island they would most like to visit and give reasons why; create class graph
3.	<i>What are the similarities and differences between ancient and modern Greece?</i> Reconnect; How many Greek islands can they name in two minutes? Activity; similarities and differences chart- specifically features- weather, terrain, ports, trade, tourism, monuments, landmarks What would have changed? Why? Compare pictures of modern Athens and Crete with visuals of ancient Greece What do the Greek people do now for a living? Has this changed? How?
